On-Going Safety Measures & New Households Guidance

The safety of our team & guests is very important to us. Before re-opening we introduced a numbers of measures to reduce risk. These include extra cleaning, hand sanitising stations, reduced capacity and space between tables. We've also extended table service throughout our indoor space.

The latest guidance on meeting others at the Scape House is as follows....

Inside Tables - Max 6 People (One Household)

The current local guidance is that each table must only host one household or bubble. There's also to be no more than six guests per table.

Outside Tables - Max 6 People (Up To Six Households)

Tables can be reserved for outdoor dining & drinks, weather permitting. The local guidance for outdoor beer gardens allows any number of households to meet, up to a maximum of six people.

We ask that before drinking or dining with us you respect the latest guidelines on self-isolating should you or anyone in your household show symptoms, and be aware of the measures in place on your visit.
